| Name of Code                  | Notification | General Instructions  |
|-------------------------------|--------------|---|
| <b>CODE RED</b>               | <b>9-911</b> | <b>RACE: <u>R</u>escue anyone in immediate danger. <u>A</u>larm - pull fire alarm, dial 6600, request that CODE RED be paged and 911 called. State the location, size and type of fire. <u>C</u>lose all doors. <u>E</u>xtinguish the fire if you can do so safely.</b> |
| <b>CODE YELLOW – EXTERNAL</b> | <b>6600</b>  | External Disaster. Mass Casualty Incident with an influx of patients. Dial 6600 then, Operator calls Administrator on Call.   |
| <b>CODE YELLOW - INTERNAL</b> | <b>6600</b>  | Unspecified Internal Disaster. Call 6600 to request CODE YELLOW-INTERNAL be paged, state the area and nature of the disaster.   |
| <b>CODE BLACK</b>             | <b>9-911</b> | <b>Bomb Threat. Keep caller on phone, have another person call 6600 and inform the operator and state location. (Use bomb threat sheet.) <i>DO NOT TOUCH OR MOVE ANYTHING SUSPICIOUS.</i></b>   |
| <b>CODE GRAY WATCH</b>        |              | Tornado Watch.  |
| <b>CODE GRAY WARNING</b>      |              | Tornado Warning. Move patients away from windows. Incident Commander will decide when to stop procedures.   |
| <b>CODE ORANGE</b>            | <b>9-911</b> | <b>Hazardous Materials Spill. Notify Engineering (and for a small spill use department spill kit if available). Do <u>not</u> call housekeeping until after Engineering has completed hazardous waste cleanup.</b>  |
| <b>CODE BLUE</b>              | <b>9-911</b> | <b>Adult Cardiac and/or respiratory arrest. Dial 9-911 and activate Emergency Management System.</b>  |
| <b>CODE WHITE</b>             | <b>9-911</b> | Pediatric Cardiac and/or respiratory arrest. Dial 9-911 to activate Emergency Management System.  |
| <b>CODE ADAM – INFANT</b>     | <b>9-911</b> | Infant Abduction. Call 6600 and request CODE ADAM INFANT” be paged state the area and description of child and/or suspect if possible. Call 9-911 to activate Emergency Management System.  |
| <b>CODE ADAM – CHILD</b>      | <b>9-911</b> | Child abduction or child lost. Call 6600 and request “CODE ADAM CHILD” be paged, state the area and description of the child and/or suspect if possible. Call 9-911 to activate Emergency Management System.  |
| <b>CODE PURPLE</b>            | <b>9-911</b> | <b>Assistance needed, combative person, person out of control. Call 6600, request CODE PURPLE be paged and state location.</b>  |
| <b>CODE SILVER</b>            | <b>6600</b>  | Person with a weapon and/or hostage situation. Call 6600 and request CODE SILVER be paged and state the location. Dial 9-911 to activate Emergency Management System  |
| <b>CODE FLIGHT</b>            | <b>6600</b>  | Patient elopement or wandering.   |
