

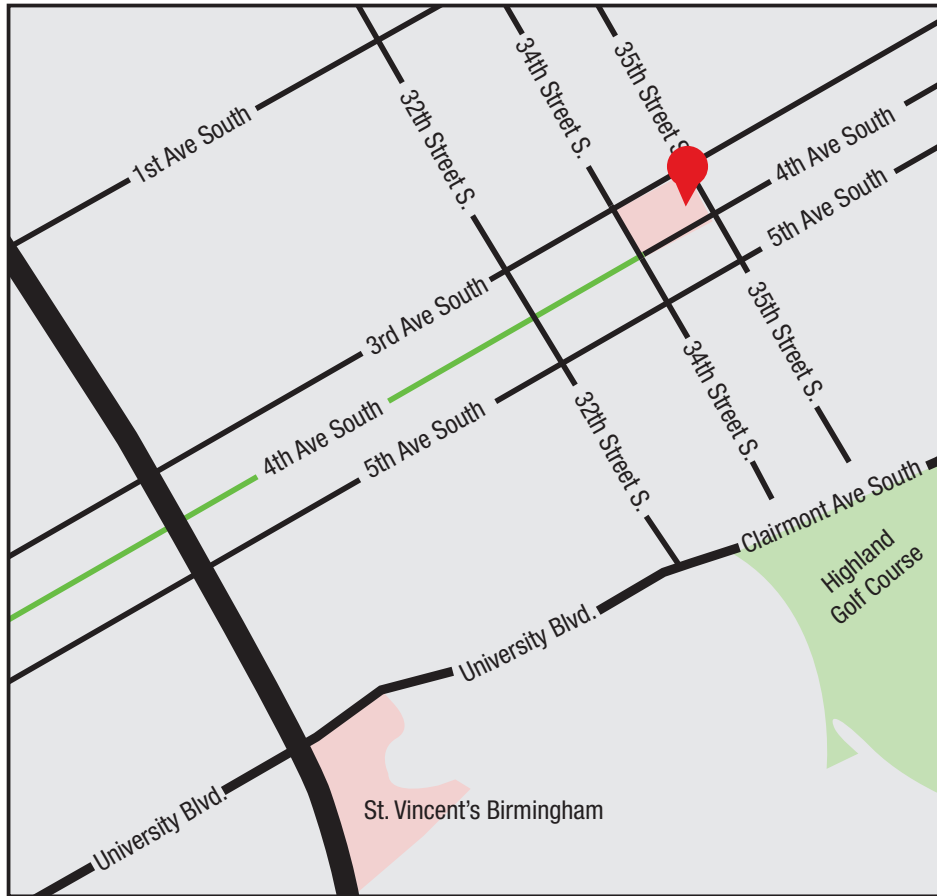

East Lot - 3405 4th Avenue South
Birmingham, AL 35222



From Red Mountain Expressway (Highway 280)

1. Exit onto 4th Avenue South.
2. Head east to 34th Street South and turn left.
3. Proceed for ½ mile. The gate to the parking lot will be on your right.
4. The code for the gate is the # symbol followed by the two digits of the month and the two digits for the year (ex. May 2012's code would be #0512).

Entrance to the lot is always from **34th Street South**.

Exit from the lot is always on **35th Street South**.

- East Lot Shuttle runs from 4:30 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

From Red Mountain Expressway (Highway 280)

1. Take the University Boulevard Exit west toward UAB.
2. Turn left onto 23rd Street South.
3. Proceed forward one block.
4. Turn right onto 9th Avenue South. The gated lot is directly to your left.
5. The code for the gate is the # symbol followed by the two digits of the month and the two digits for the year (ex. May 2012's code would be #0512).

Important Information

- West Lot Shuttle runs from 5:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The shuttle runs a continuous loop from the West Lot to POB 1 during peak hours from 6:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. – 6:00pm. At any other time, call Dispatch for the shuttle at 930-8760 (x2760 from an on-campus phone).
- The shuttle will pick-up/drop-off at the South Tower upon request only.

EMERGENCY CODES
ST. VINCENT'S Birmingham**

Name of Code	Notification	General Instructions
CODE RED	27223 (2-RACE)	RACE: Rescue anyone in immediate danger. Alarm - pull fire alarm, dial 27223, request that CODE RED be paged. State the location, size and type of fire. Close all doors. Extinguish the fire if you can do so safely.
CODE YELLOW – EXTERNAL	Admin. On Call Pager 889-1234	External Disaster. Mass Casualty Incident with an influx of patients. Notify Administrator on Call at pager 889-1234.
CODE YELLOW - INTERNAL	22255	Unspecified Internal Disaster. Call 22255 to request CODE YELLOW-INTERNAL be paged, state the area and nature of the disaster.
CODE BLACK	22255	Bomb Threat. Keep caller on phone, have another person call 22255 and inform the dispatcher and state location. (Use bomb threat sheet.) <i>DO NOT TOUCH OR MOVE ANYTHING SUSPICIOUS.</i>
CODE GRAY WATCH		Tornado Watch.
CODE GRAY WARNING		Tornado Warning. Move patients away from windows and do not start new procedures. Incident Commander will decide when to implement this Code.
CODE ORANGE	22255	Hazardous Materials Spill. Ask Security to Notify Engineering (and for a small spill use department spill kit if available). Do <u>not</u> call housekeeping until after Engineering has completed hazardous waste cleanup.
CODE BLUE	27777	Adult Cardiac and/or respiratory arrest. Dial 27777 and request that a CODE BLUE be paged and state location.
CODE WHITE	27777	Pediatric Cardiac and/or respiratory arrest. Dial 27777 and request that a CODE WHITE be paged and state location.
RAPID RESPONSE	27823	Immediate assistance needed for patient with change in status. If nurse deems patient is deteriorating then rapid response team should be called stating location.
CODE ADAM – INFANT	22255	Infant Abduction. Use radio to contact Security with specific information about area, infant and suspect. Security will call switchboard and request CODE ADAM INFANT" be paged. Call 22255 to report someone suspicious.
CODE ADAM – CHILD	22255	Child abduction or child lost. Call 22255 and request "CODE ADAM CHILD" be paged, state the area and description of the child and suspect.
CODE PURPLE	22255	Assistance needed, combative person, person out of control. Call 22255, request CODE PURPLE be paged and state location.
CODE SILVER	22255	Person with a weapon and/or hostage situation. Call 22255 and request CODE SILVER be paged and state the location.
CODE EXIT	22255	Patient elopement or wandering.
